**SHERATON HOUSTON BROOKHOLLOW DONATES
BANQUET CHAIRS TO HOUSTON FURNITURE BANK**

HOUSTON, TX – When the recently-renovated Sheraton Houston Brookhollow Hotel received new, ergonomic banquet seating for its meeting and event space, hotel General Manager Jack Farr was faced with a challenge: find a home for the hundreds of gently-worn hotel banquet chairs that were about to be replaced.
